

## The order below makes allowances for the Officer to park this vehicle in a restricted area whilst carrying out their duties

The London Borough of Havering Traffic Management Order 1994 number 11, schedule 4, section 14.1, sub-section c states;

14.1 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this order any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours in any part of a parking place if the use of that part has been suspended and if:

(c) The Vehicle is being used in the service of a Local Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting.

Provision in the Greater London Council (General Powers) Act 1974, as amended by the London Local Authorities Act 2000, enables the Council as a Highway Authority to authorise the parking of a specified vehicle such as the CCTV car on parking restrictions, whilst in the pursuance of their duties.

It is never the intention of the service to cause hazardous conditions or create a dangerous situation.
