1. An Election is to be held of One Member of Parliament for Hornchurch & Upminster Constituency

2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election, may be obtained from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Town Hall, Main Road, Romford, RM1 3BD on any working day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10am and 4pm but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.
4. The required deposit of £500 can be made by the deposit of any legal tender (cash), or, by means of a banker's draft (made payable to the Returning Officer Havering).
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
6. Applications, to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Main Road, Romford, RM1 3BD by the deadline of the 18 June 2024. Applications can be made online by visiting www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Main Road, Romford, RM1 3BD by 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024. Applications can be made online by visiting www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Electors Document valid for this election, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online by visiting www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate
9. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Main Road, Romford, RM1 3BD by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. Applications can be made online by visiting www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity, for work/service, or Photo ID reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Main Road, Romford, RM1 3BD by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
